In general, the trees in Withersfield are looking well, although there is a small Chestnut in the corner of Burton Green that is in a state of decline and may not last too many more years. The Ash are showing more and more signs of decline in places also, especially the smaller hedgerow ones, they seem very late in coming out this year.

I'm hoping that the winter will have helped the Chestnuts in Town Green by cutting down the numbers of the Leaf Minor Moths, we will see.

I am always keeping an eye on the trees in the Village; however I would be happy for anyone to contact me should they have any concerns over any of the trees in the public areas of the Village.
