## Withersfield Parish Council

### **DRAFT Annual Accounts for 2018-19**

This report summarises the income and expenditure for the year ending 31 March 2019. It outlines how the Parish Council has used the money entrusted to it for the benefit of residents of the parish.

It also outlines how the Parish Council intends to use the funds available to it during the current year.

#### **Background:**

The annual accounts of the Parish Council should be approved at the first Parish Council meeting following the end of the Financial Year. For Withersfield this is our meeting on 14<sup>th</sup> May.

The income from Council Tax precept available to the Parish Council increased in 2018-19 over previous years as the Arboretum estate is completed and fully occupied. However, we have received less income from the graveyard in comparison to previous years meaning that costs of graveyard maintenance (grass cutting, filling sunken graves, mole control) has not been covered by income this year. Income from this source is not predictable and may well rise again in the current and future years.

We received grant totalling £1,570 during the year, which included funding towards the war memorial renovation and for installing litter bins at Meldrum reservoir. These grants ensured that these Parish projects could proceed enhancing the allocated sum of £1,500 set aside for projects from reserves.

The draft accounts will be passed to our internal auditor (SALC) and any comments or observations will be reported to a Parish Council meeting.

#### **Balances:**

Balances at the end of 2018/19 have increased from £19,532 to £19,786, this includes earmarked reserves of £5,000 set aside for maintenance of Parish assets.

In addition, the Parish Council has decided that it will invest in additional traffic calming measures during the coming year – including a contribution towards the introduction of 40mph buffer zones and further measures that come forward from the Traffic Working Party. Whilst it is prudent to maintain adequate reserves (up to 2 times the annual Council income) the current level of reserves should enable Councillors to fulfil these ambitions, particularly if linked to specific additional fund raising and grant applications.
